## Adult Leader/Student Leader Job Description

1. Serve on a team of 4+ people to lead a Back Yard Bible Club.
2. Study all Bible lessons in the Back Yard Bible Club curriculum.
3. Attend at least one training for "Rock the Block".
4. Be prepared to teach the lesson, do a gospel presentation, give your testimony, lead the assigned craft (optional) and lead the games/recreation activities.
5. Based on your team's gifts, abilities and talents and interests, assign each day's responsibilities to each team member. These include: teaching the Bible lesson, leading the craft, distributing snacks and leading the games/rec time, teaching the indicated gospel presentation, and giving a personal testimony.
6. Be available to meet with your team to practice your assigned duties for each day. For example you may be teaching the Bible lesson each day, or leading crafts each day, or your team may take turns leading each responsibility.
7. Arrive at your club location each day 30 minute prior to the start of "Rock the Block" to set up and have prayer time.
8. If a child trusts in Christ as Savior for the first time, complete the Celebration card. Place the Celebration Card in the designated envelope in your RTB tub.
9. Greet children as they arrive and direct them to the early arrival activities.
