/ The Urban Sprawl of Seattle

/ Why Church Planting in Seattle?

The greater Seattle area includes almost 4 million people, only an estimated 4% of which belong to an evangelical faith community. The largest percentage of the population is Caucasian, yet there is also an expanding Asian, Hispanic, and African-American presence.

We believe we can reach the nations by reaching the city's urban sprawl. A gospel-centered church with a global, disciple-making vision located therein will have a strategic vantage point to see lives transformed throughout the world.
