Questions

When the Israelites were in the wilderness, how did God show the Israelites that He was enough, He was sufficient, to supply all their needs? How did God show the Israelites that His power was unlimited?

Questions

Did God give Abram a son immediately? Why or why not?

Answers

God made Abram wait a long time before He gave Abram a son. He wanted to show Abram that he is El Shaddai, God Almighty and as El Shaddai He could give Abram a son when Abram was 99 years old. He wanted to teach Abram about faith. He wanted to teach Abram to trust Him.

Answers

God knew the Israelites had a need for food while they were in the wilderness because God knows everything. He supplied their food every day by "raining" down manna from Heaven. He not only gave the Israelites what they needed to eat, He also provided enough manna that there was manna left on the ground. He gave them more than they needed.

Questions

What other times can you think of when God showed the Israelites that He was all powerful?

Answers

Parting the Red Sea, healing them from snake bites, delivering them from Goliath using David when David was a boy, giving them water in the wilderness out of a rock.

Review

EL SHADDAI, God Almighty

God revealed Himself as El Shaddai, God Almighty to Abram and told Abram of the covenant he was establishing with him and with his descendants. Until the time of Moses, when another name of God was revealed, the people considered El Shaddai the covenant name of God. When we pray to El Shaddai, we are praying to the One who for whom nothing is impossible!

Pray the Name: Lord, help me to know you as El Shaddai, my All Powerful God, the one who is able to lift me up, nourish me, bless me and fulfill every promise that you make. Increase my awe and wonder of you, and of your power, so that that I will follow you faithfully like Abraham always believing you are enough for me.

ELOHIM, STRONG CREATOR: Strong, Mighty, Powerful Creator

JEHOVAH, YAHWEH: I AM: Self Existent One, Unchanging One
