What does Adonai mean?

Answers

1. Lordship shows ownership. God made us so He has the right to do with us what He wants.
2. Master means we, as servants have a working relationship. A master provides everything the servant needs like clothes, shelter, food. A master also provides direction and training. "Adonai" means that God has more responsibility than His people.

Questions

Do we always want to do what God tells us to do?
Do we always want to accept His assignments?

Answers

1. God told Moses to go speak to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt. Moses said "No, I cannot speak well enough." 2. God asked "Who shall I send?" to tell the world about me? Isaiah said, "Here I am. Send me!" 3. God told Jonah to go to Nineveh to tell the people to repent. Jonah did not obey and went the other way instead. 4. God told Mary she was to have a son and that she was to name him "Jesus". Mary said, "I am your servant. May it be as you say."

Answers

NO. Sometimes what God asks us to do is not what we want to do. Sometimes, it does not fit into our plans. His plans may make us feel uncomfortable, it may not be convenient, it may be hard to do, it may be embarrassing

Questions

Why should we obey God even when we don't like the assignment?

Answers

When we commit our lives to Jesus, when we trust in Him as our Savior, we are making Him LORD of our lives. God becomes ADONAI. He has the right to direct everything we do. We will only find real joy if we are obedient to God. He knows what is good for us and what is best or us.

ADONAI is a Hebrew word meaning "Lord" a name that means we have a relationship with God. We are His servants. It appears more than 300 times in the Hebrew scriptures. When you pray to **Adonai**, tell Him you want to surrender every aspect of your life to Him. Pray for grace to become the kind of servant who is quick to do God's will.

PRAY THE NAME! Father God I acknowledge that You are my Adonai, Lord of my life. Please forgive me for the times that I have not obeyed you when you have told me to do something. Please forgive me when I have prayed one thing and done another. Help me to accept all of your assignments instead of doing things my way. Help me to experience the joy of serving You, my Lord and my God. Amen.
