JEHOVAH-JIREH—THE LORD WILL PROVIDE

Questions

What does "Jireh" mean?

Answers

"Jireh" comes from the Hebrew word "to see". God knows what we need even before we do. He knows our needs ahead of time (He "foresees"), and provides for those needs.

Questions

What message did God's prophet, Elijah bring to Ahab? What does this message teach you about God?

Answers

Elijah told Ahab that God would send a drought and that there would be neither dew nor rain for a few years. This message shows that God is all-powerful and can command the forces of nature.

Questions

How did God show he is Jehovah Jireh to Elijah?

Answers

God foresaw Elijah's need for food and water and God provided for Elijah's need. God has all of creation at his disposal.

Questions

How did God provide for Elijah's need?

Answers

God commanded ravens to bring Elijah bread and bread and meat in the evening. God provided Elijah with water from a certain brook. God also commanded a widow to provide for Elijah.

Questions

In what 2 ways did God show Himself as Jehovah Jireh to the widow and her son?

Answers

God provided food for the widow and her son by performing a miracle of healing when the widow's son was sick and stopped breathing. God also showed Himself as Jehovah Jireh by performing a miracle of healing when the widow's son was sick and stopped breathing. God healed the boy by bringing him back to life.

Questions

Why did God ask Abraham to sacrifice his son Isaac?

Answers

God tested Abraham to show Abraham's faith and fear of God, in increase Abraham's faith and to reveal Himself as Jehovah Jireh, The Lord will Provide.

What other need did God show us He was providing when He provided the ram for the sacrifice?

Questions

Answers

God provided for our spiritual need. Abraham had the wood and fire but God provided the ram as a substitute sacrifice so Abraham did not have to sacrifice his son, Isaac. This substitute sacrifice was a picture of an even greater sacrifice that would be made for man's sin. Jehovah Jireh knew we would have a need of a permanent sacrifice for our sin. God knew we needed a Savior. \*The ram dying for the sin of Abraham is a picture of Jesus dying for us. However, unlike the ram, Jesus is a permanent—the one and only—sacrifice. Jehovah Jireh saw our need for someone to bear our sins and He provided His own Son, Jesus!

Questions

How did the Lord provide for the widow whose sons were going to be sold into slavery to pay her debts?

Answers

God showed Himself Jehovah Jireh by providing enough oil for the widow to sell in order to make money to pay her debts. She and her sons were able to live on the left over money after the debts were paid.

Questions

How did God provide for Abraham on Mount Moriah?

Answers

God provided a ram for the offering.

**JEHOVAH JIREH**

The Hebrew word "raah" means to "to see". It is translated as "provide". Since God sees the future as well as the past and the present, He is able to anticipate and provide for what is needed. The English word "provision" is made up of two Latin words that mean "to see beforehand." When you pray to Jehovah Jireh, you are praying to the God who sees the situation beforehand and is able to provide for your needs.

Pray the Name: "Jehovah Jireh, the Lord who provides for me, thank you for all of your blessings. Thank you for forgiveness and faith, purpose and hope, food and shelter, family and friends, strength and wisdom, rest and work, laughter and light. Your blessings will never come to an end because you are a God if never ending grace. Amen."
