EL ROI, the God Who Sees

<p><i>Questions</i></p> <p>What technology do we use to "see" inside people?</p>	<p><i>Questions</i></p> <p>Why is one of God's names EL ROI?</p>	<p><i>Questions</i></p> <p>What did God "see" when he chose David as the 2nd king over Israel? Was this the person Samuel would have thought God would choose as king over Israel? Why or why not?</p>	<p><i>Answers</i></p> <p>David was not who Samuel thought God would have chosen. Samuel was looking at the outward appearance and thought God would have chosen someone else who was taller and probably older. God could see David's heart. God knew what kind of person David was. He knew David's needs, and He knew David's motives.</p>
<p><i>Answers</i></p> <p>X-Ray or Ultrasound</p>	<p><i>Answers</i></p> <p>Because God can see even "deeper" than an X-Ray or an Ultrasound. God's name, EL ROI, talks about His sight. God "sees" our heart and "sees" what we need. He watches over us with tenderness and compassion.</p>

Questions

Who was Hagar? When Abram and Sarai didn't wait on God to give them the son God had promised them, what did they do?

Answers

Hagar was Abram and Sarai's Egyptian servant. Sarai gave Hagar to Abram for Abram and Hagar to have a child together.

Questions

Who found Hagar and talked to her? What was she promised? What did Hagar say to God?

Answers

An angel of the Lord found Hagar in the desert. The angel of the Lord told Hagar to go back to Sarai and Abram and to do what they told her to do as their servant. The angel told Hagar that she would have a son and that her descendants would be too many to count. Hagar said to God, "You are the God who sees me."

Questions

How did God show that He could "see" Hagar's heart?

Questions

When Hagar became pregnant with a child, how did Sarai act? What did Hagar do?

Answers

Sarai was mean to Hagar. She was jealous because Hagar was able to have a child and she had not been able to so far. Hagar ran away because Sarai had been so mean to her.

Answers

God did not despise Hagar for what she had done. He did not forget about her or get rid of her. He understood why she was so upset and He had compassion on her. God could also "see" her son, Ishmael growing as a baby inside her.

Questions

Read Psalm 121, Psalm 34:15, Proverbs 15:3, Psalm 11:4, Job 34:21 and Job 36:7. What does God's Word tell you about EL ROI, The God Who Sees?

Answers

The Lord watches over His children. He knows where we are and what is going on in our lives and He answers our prayers. He knows what is going on in the next room, another city, in other countries, under the sea and in the mountains. He sees everything all the time. God sees our intentions; our motives. He has compassion but He will also judge us. He sees and knows every step we make and we are always under His care.

EL ROI: Hagar's encounter with God in the desert is the only time in the Bible EL ROI is used as a name for God. Hagar's God is the One who numbers the hairs on your head and knows our circumstances from the past, present and future. When you pray to EL ROI you are praying to the One who knows everything about you.

Pray the Name: Lord, I praise you as EL ROI, for you know the whole story from beginning to end. You see everything. Help me to admit when I cannot do something and to come to you, and trust you to take care of me and know what is best for me. Help me to do what is right in your eyes and to make good choices. Help me to see You and come to know You for who you are. Amen.
