Question:

In the experiment/illustration in large group when a paper cup and a glass cup was used, how did you know which cup the penny was hidden under?

Answer:

One of the cups was glass and the penny was visible.

Question:

When the penny was hidden using two paper cups, how did you know which cup the penny was under?

Answer:

A sign was on the cup that said, "The penny is under this cup." You really didn't know the penny was under the cup even though the sign said so. Sometimes the truth is not clear and it is sometimes hard to tell a lie from the truth.

Question:

When God commanded that Adam and Eve not eat the fruit from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, what did God tell them would happen if they did eat the fruit from that tree?

Question:

What did the serpent (Satan, the Devil) say would happen if they ate the fruit from that tree?

Answer:

The serpent (Satan) told them they would not die.

Answer:

They would die.

Question:

Can both be telling the truth? How do we know that God told the truth and Satan lied?

Answer:

1. Both God's and Satan's statements cannot be true. God spoke the truth. 2. Death did enter the world because Adam and Eve disobeyed God. God had to kill an animal because Adam and Eve ate the fruit He told them not to. Adam and Eve began dying that day. 3. The Word tells us that God is the source of all truth and that it is impossible for Him to lie. God is JEHOVAH-EL EMEHTH, The LORD God of Truth.

Question:

What does the Bible say about Satan and lies?

Answer:

The Word says that Satan is the "father of all lies." It says Satan is a murderer and a liar.

Question:

Why do people lie? Why doesn't God lie?

Answer:

People lie so as not to get in trouble, to gain power, to get something they want, to make themselves look good. Lying is a sin and people sin. God doesn't have any of these needs. He does need power because He is all powerful. He does not need material things because He is self-existent, God always does what He says He will do. God is perfect. He is without sin.

Question:

How can you recognize a lie from Satan?

Answer:

1. If what Satan (or someone else) says is different—opposite from what God says, you will know it is a lie. 2. Know JEHOVAH-EL EMEHTH, The God of Truth and pray to Him and ask for His protection from Satan's lies. 3. Know the Bible. Memorize scripture and repeat it often. If you know the truth, then it is easier to recognize. 4. Question what you see and hear. Check it out! Check it against what God says. Know what you believe and why you believe it!
