Bible Skills

5. Find chapters and verses called for in a Bible reference.
6. Identify the books with some of the men used to write the Bible.
7. Identify key books by information contained in them. For example:

Exodus tells about Moses

The 10 Commandments are found in Exodus

Jesus' birth is recorded in Luke

1 Samuel tells the story of David and Goliath

Acts tells us about the early church

Scripture

1. Learn and be able to recite by memory a minimum of 20 key Bible verses. These are in addition to the 12 learned in 1st grade. See the attached list for the recommended 2nd grade scriptures.
2. Learn what the 20 scriptures mean and how they may apply to our lives.

Becoming a Christian

1. Learn that there is a place called Heaven and Hell and to understand the difference.
2. Learn what sin is and be able to list sins.

3. Learn the ABC's of becoming a Christian.
A-Admit you are a sinner
B-Believe that Jesus is God's Son
C-Confess your faith in Jesus as your Savior and Lord
4. Learn that Jesus did not die on the cross by accident. Understand that this was God's plan for us to be able to have our sins forgiven and go to Heaven.
5. Learn that baptism does not make you a Christian.
6. Learn that you do not become a Christian by doing good works, that you are not a Christian because your parents are, because you are in church every week, or go to a Christian School, etc.
7. Learn that not everyone is a Christian and that many people will go to Hell when they die.

Answer Key to the "Houses" (Incremental Learning Goals)
2nd Grade

Bible

1. Recognize the Bible as a book from God.
2. Learn that the Bible is God's gift to us.
3. Learn that the Bible is the only book we can trust to always be right.
4. Learn that the Bible is the inspired Word of God. When children leave 1st grade they should know how the Bible came to be. (God breathed the words into the minds of about 40 different men.)
5. Know other names for the Bible: God's Word, Holy Word, A Map, the Sword, Flashlight, Holy Book, The Book, Compass, Rule Book, etc.

Bible Skills

8. Know all the Books of the Bible in order.
9. Pronounce all the Books of the Bible correctly.
10. Use the contents page to locate any book.
11. Read a Bible Reference.
12. Find chapters and verses called for in a Bible reference.
13. 4 Gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John
14. Know that the Old Testament tells us how the world and man was created and about things that happened BEFORE Jesus was born.
15. Know that the New Testament tells us about Jesus' birth, ministry, death, and resurrection, and everything that happened after Jesus was born leading up to the first church.
