Fighting Legalism: 3 Ways

Legalism believes that we can <u>earn</u> or keep God's <u>favor</u> by <u>what</u> we do.

1) Legalism distorts.

• The Pharisees have a shallow understanding of worship (v. 6-7a), authority (v. 7b-13), and morality (v. 14-23).

2) Sin defiles.

• Big idea: <u>Sin</u> comes from <u>within</u> (v. 15, 20, 23).

3) Jesus saves.

- Jesus moves from a conversation with those who think they're clean (V5) to a conversation with a woman who knows she's dirty (v. 24-28).
- The ritually clean are <u>morally</u> dirty, and the morally dirty receive <u>mercy</u> from God.
