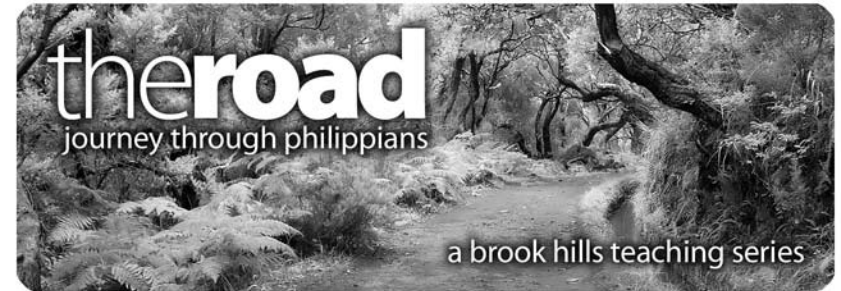

- **A Son**
 - ▶ Disciple-making is like a father and **son**, or mother and **daughter** relationship.
 - ▶ We can have a spiritual child through **birth** or **adoption**.
- **A Student**
 - ▶ Disciple-making is like a teacher and a student relationship.
 - ▶ The discipler is a co-**learner** with the one he is training.
 - ▶ There is a difference between **teaching** and **training**.
 - ▶ The student is a **teacher** in the making.
- **A Servant**
 - ▶ Disciple-making is the highest form of servant **leadership** and servant **friendship**.
 - ▶ Timothy did not exist to make **Paul** a success but **Paul** existed to make **Timothy** a success.
 - ▶ Only those who are **secure** will ever **serve** others.
- **A Substitute**
 - ▶ Disciple-making requires the teacher to **step** aside and use the student as a substitute for continued growth and training of the disciple.
 - ▶ This is the key to **multiplication** because it allows the “**original**” to be some where else at the same time.
- **A Steward**
 - ▶ Disciple-making is like being a steward managing **assets** and **interest** for the owner’s benefit and future return.
 - ▶ The greatest stewardship is **succession**.
 - ▶ Disciple-making relationships include **all** of these examples.
- Through the disciple-making process we have: Spiritual **Succession**
- God’s **multiplication** Table: II Timothy 2:2
- The basic standard here is **four** generations deep of disciple-making.
