



Assignment One: God's Story and My Story

GOD'S STORY (EXAMPLE) ...

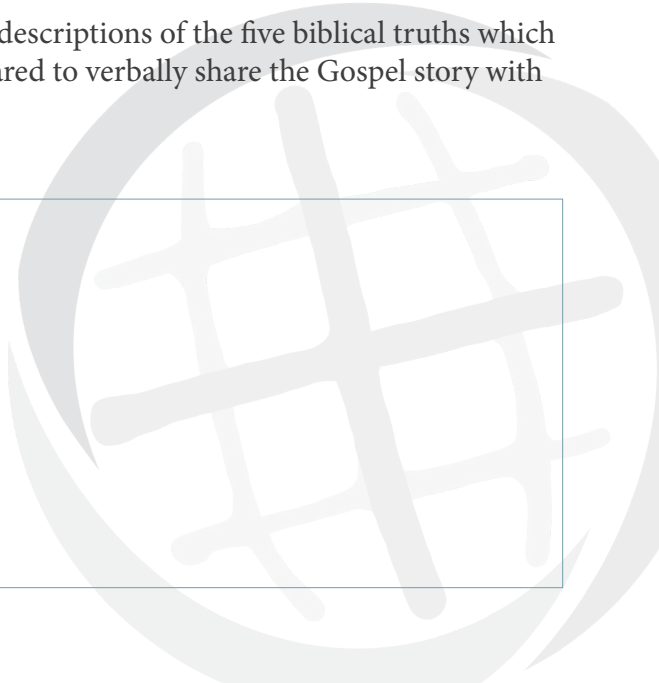
